

# By *Accident?*

The word “accident” is fast disappearing from mention of incidents



that involve *Local Attorney* colliding vehicles. The term “car crash” now largely replaces the term “car accident.”

The word “accident” implies that the event “just happened” and no one is at fault. Car crashes, however, and similar occurrences are very often the result of someone’s negligence, carelessness, or recklessness.

Thus, when a crash or other incident that causes injury, either bodily or property, occurs, there should be a determination of who is at fault and liable.

This process should begin with a consultation between a lawyer and the injured party. Under no circumstances should those involved in an “accident” discuss blame with the other people involved in the incident.

**REMEMBER:** If you are involved in a vehicular crash, simply collect information and wait to speak with your attorney. Admit or say nothing else.
